Atlas Copco has its active presence in Egypt thru a regional office in Beirut "Atlas Copco Middle East" covering Iraq, Lebanon, Jordan, Syria, Bahrain, Saudi Arabia via established distributors with showrooms & after sales services.

The joint venture agreement was conducted in Cairo Egypt, by Atlas Copco Group and Alkan Enterprises to form a majority-owned sales company under the name of the "Egyptian International Service & Engineering" (EISE) located in Mokatam serving customers in an even more focused manner



Atlas Copco introduced the Variable Speed Drive compressor technology in the Egyptian market. The first VSD machine (GA37 VSD) was sold in Egypt to "LEONI Egypt Co".



The distributors in Jordan, Syria and Lebanon together with Libya came under the responsibility of Atlas Copco Egypt.



The first two NGP (Nitrogen Generator) were sold by Atlas Copco Egypt to OILSERV in Iraq OILSERV has one of the largest privately owned fleets of brand-new oilfield equipment in the Middle East & North Africa region



In August 25, Atlas Copco CompressorTechnique Service Division (CTS) has inaugurated a regional training academy located in Egypt for providing training courses on Atlas Copco stationary compressed air systems within MENA region under the Motto "Committed to competence develoment" On February 2017, the academy extended its scope of support to include the CTS Competence development & training activities for all African countries.

Atlas Copco in Egypt goes back to the early fifties through a trading house in Sweden operating the business in Egypt "Egyptian Swedish Trading Company" (ESTC).



Atlas Conco compressors & drilling equipment were used for the construction of the High Dam project in Aswan, one of the greatest projects of the 20th century & in the history of Egypt & Africa.



Atlas Copco compressors & drilling machines expanded in Egypt under the first licensed agency "Egyptian Swedish Trading Company" (ESTC) with its head office in the Downtown, whereas its workshop & warehouse were located close to Sakkara pyramid. The agency was reporting directly to "Atlas Copco International" in Belgium and succeeded to create a stable brand presence during that period of time.



In April 1, Atlas Copco Equipment Egypt Ltd. (ACEE) was established as a legal independent customer center with the head office in Cairo & a branch at Alexandria - started with around 50 employees & new independent offices and service areas committed to deliver reliable products with an unparalleled level of efficiency & superior aftermarket services.



Atlas Copco Egypt supplied the first RC drilling machine (ROCL8 RC) to the first modern gold mine in Egypt & the Middle East "Egypt Sukari Gold Mine" (SGM) which has been actively exploring in Egypt since 1995, via its wholly owned subsidiary company. Pharaoh Gold Mines NL (PGM) using Atlas Copco exploration machines



March 22, was the inauguration for "Atlas Copco Levant" to strengthen the presence and relations with customers in the region. The office in Lebanon is the regional coordination center of Atlas Copco's Compressor Technique business area for Lebanon, Iraq, Libya, Syria & Jordan.
