

Information of Atlas Copco IAS GmbH according to Art. 13 and 14, GDPR

Dear Customer / Prospective Customer,

Atlas Copco IAS GmbH considers data protection to be very important. In the interests of transparency and in terms of Art. 13 of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), we would therefore like to inform you about our data processing.

3. What categories of personal data are processed and where do the personal data originate from?

In general, we process all data that are required for the realization of contracts and that are stated in the respective contractual documentation, such as contact data, project data, accounting data and banking data.

We also process data that we have collected from other sources in line with the regulations. This includes creditworthiness information from credit agencies and/or credit scoring firms.

4. For what purposes are the data processed, and on what specific legal basis?

We process the contact data and contractual data of our contractual partners for the purpose of forging the contract (issuing the offer, for example), the conclusion of the contract, and for the realization of the contract (completion of orders, completion of projects) according to Art. 6 (1) (b), GDPR. The specific purposes of the data processing are oriented to the respective contents of the contract, in which you are also able to view them. We shall process your contact data for trial proposals in the interests of presenting you with interesting products and applications. For a robot training course, we issue safety instructions according to Art. 6 (c), GDPR. We also process your data for accounting purposes according to Art. 6 (1) (b and c) of the GDPR for the management of payment flows and for invoicing purposes.

Our reception desk processes the contact data of our customers in order to prepare for their visit in the best possible way.

For advertising purposes, it may be the case that we send you interesting offers, information and Christmas cards from Atlas Copco IAS by post or email and also invite you to events and gatherings according to Art. 6 (1) (f), GDPR. We may take photos at such gatherings with your consent according to Art. 6 (1 a), GDPR. We also carry out customer satisfaction surveys according to Art. 6 (1 a) and (f), GDPR. We also process your data on the basis of Art. 6 (1) (f) GDPR in order to prevent or clarify criminal offenses, and to ensure and further develop our IT security. According to Art. 6 (1 f), GDPR, we also process emails from our customers to ensure our communication capability, IT security and archiving. If you visit us at our location, we will provide you with WiFi access, in the course of which we will process your data according to Art. 6 (1 f), GDPR.

According to Art. 6 (1) (c), GDPR, we are also subject to various differing legal obligations, according to which we have to process your data. These include requirements according to tax law and the screening of our customer contacts for terrorists or sanction lists.

We shall also process your data on the basis of consent which we obtain separately according to Art. 6 (1 a), GDPR. The appropriate purpose and reach is based on the respective consent.

5. To which recipients or categories of recipients are data transferred?

We will handle your data confidentially. Within Atlas Copco IAS GmbH, the principle of data economy applies, which means only those persons who are entrusted with the respective task are able to access your data. We shall only forward your data in accordance with the legal requirements. The following categories of recipients can receive the data:

- IT service providers who assist us with the maintenance of IT systems,
- Software manufacturers who gain access to our systems in the scope of remote maintenance and maintenance.
- Providers of cloud services who provide us with storage space or provide us with software as a service (SAAS)
- Lawyers, credit institutes, providers of print services, providers of logistics and postal services, providers of marketing, support and consulting services.

Atlas Copco IAS is a subsidiary of Atlas Copco, which is based at Atlas Copco Industrial Technique AB Sickla Industriväg 19, Stockholm, 10523 Sweden. Personal data will not be transferred, however, without the existence of a legal basis.

6. For how long will your data be stored?

Data that are stored upon collection will be erased at the end of the statutory retention and limitation periods or once the original purpose of the collection lapses, whichever period is the longer.

7. Rights of data subjects

a) Transparency / right of access

Under the above address, we will be pleased to inform you of data that we have stored regarding your person.

b) Rectification and completion of stored data

We will naturally rectify and complete your personal data without delay if we become aware that it is incorrect or incomplete, or you provide us with the appropriate notification.

c) Erasure of stored data

The erasure of your data takes place according to the aforementioned regulations. We shall also erase your data if you would like us to and an appropriate claim exists, for example, the possible lapse of the purpose of the processing, the withdrawal of the consent, and in the event of unlawful storage.

d) Right to the restriction of processing

If one of the aforementioned reasons exists which stand in the way of an erasure, we shall restrict the use of your personal data in accordance with your requests. This means that we will store your data on a secure and inaccessible basis and only use it with your consent or in terms of one of the aforementioned obligations to provide proof.

e) Right to data portability

If you so wish, we will provide you with the data that you have provided to us in a structured, standard, machine-readable format.

f) Right to lodge a complaint

You have the right to lodge a complaint to the aforementioned Data Protection Officer or to the responsible supervisory authority for data protection at all times.

g) Right to object

According to Art. 21, GDPR, Atlas Copco IAS GmbH grants its customers the right to object to the processing of data that are processed by us on the basis of justifiable interest according to Art. 6 (1) (f), GDPR, or a government task according to Art. 6 (1) (e), GDPR, if on the basis of your situation, grounds should arise against this processing. You are also granted the right to object to direct advertising according to Art. 21 (2), GDPR.

h) Right of withdrawal

Atlas Copco IAS GmbH grants its customers the right to withdraw their consent at any time in accordance with Art. 6 (1) (a), GDPR. Send your notice of withdrawal to the following email address: ias.datenschutzbeauftragter@atlascopco.com or by post to the aforementioned postal address.
